

# Connect a Samsung Tablet to your Mac

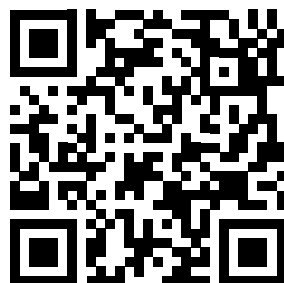
Connecting your new Samsung tablet to your PC is easy, any modern Microsoft OS recognizes Samsung tablets out of the box and will allow easy, simple file transfers with minimum hassle. But what if you own a Mac? Here's how to enable file transfers on these devices.

1. First of all, on the Mac, open up your web browser and head to:  
<http://www.android.com/filetransfer>
2. Once this is downloaded, run the DMG package and install the software. The following screenshots will give you an idea of how this process goes.
3. Once the software is installed, you can connect your Samsung tablet. Go ahead and do that now. You may receive a warning about running Android File Transfer, as it is "an application downloaded from the Internet". It is safe to ignore this warning. Go ahead and tick the "Don't warn me" option, and click Open.
4. You will then see a simple window showing the contents of your tablet. You can also see the contents of your SD/MicroSD card by clicking the appropriate tab at the top of this window.
5. From here, it is a simple task to drag and drop any files you wish to transfer to the tablet onto this window. They will be then available for any installed apps to use.
